


### ABAT Board of Directors




## Are you eligible?

*The American Academy of Clinical Toxicology recognizes individuals who have contributed to the mission of the Academy by offering their time and expertise to its initiatives.*


## What does it take to be a FAACT?



## Executive Director

The University of California San Francisco (UCSF) Department of Clinical Pharmacy in the School of Pharmacy is seeking an experienced clinician to serve as the full-time faculty Executive Director of the California Poison Control System (CPCS).

The Executive Director provides scientific, managerial, and strategic planning leadership for the CPCS with the major goals of initiating and supporting research initiatives, unifying the geographically disparate clinical sites, developing educational and training opportunities, and integrating poison control into the School of Pharmacy and fostering collaborations within the Department of Clinical Pharmacy in coordination with the Department Chair.

The successful applicant will actively contribute to the research and teaching missions of the UCSF School of Pharmacy commensurate with their faculty rank, including creating and maintaining a robust, extramurally funded research program that aligns with the research priorities of the School. The Executive Director will serve as an Associate Dean in the UCSF School of Pharmacy.

### Required Qualifications:

- PharmD or other pharmacy training/degree
- Research expertise in scientific areas relevant to poison control, such as toxicology, adverse drug effects, pharmacoepidemiology, or health services research.
- Expertise in leading multidisciplinary teams and collaboration across multiple-stakeholders in a complex healthcare system
- A strong track record of publications and external funding
- Ability to navigate complex administrative environments and build consensus among diverse groups
- Demonstrated skill in conflict resolution and managing challenging negotiations
