In today's increasingly saturated workforce, many learners find it daunting to commit to years of additional training without a clear understanding of career prospects. To address this, I aim to elevate the visibility of non-traditional toxicology career paths within the Academy, through initiatives such as informal virtual conversations with practicing toxicologists and expanded programming at NACCT, so that prospective trainees can better appreciate the breadth of opportunities beyond traditional poison center roles. Additionally, I am committed to advancing the national conversation around innovative toxicology education and fostering meaningful interprofessional collaboration by supporting the development of a research network for emerging toxicologists through the Trainee and Student Section.
