

The University of Florida Department of Emergency Medicine - Jacksonville is seeking a motivated and energetic board-certified or board-eligible medical toxicologist to join our faculty. The successful candidate will contribute to our established medical toxicology program and support ongoing expansion efforts, including development of a Medical Toxicology Fellowship, as well as an addiction clinic and/or consult service.

Clinical assignments would include shifts in general emergency medicine at our community sites, involvement in the clinical toxicology consult service, and the Florida/USVI Poison Information Center-Jacksonville. Other opportunities, such as involvement in the medical toxicology resident/fellow/student rotation and conducting or assisting with research studies (government, foundation, and industry sponsored) are also available.

Successful candidates will receive **dedicated toxicology time** (with a reduction in clinical effort) depending on their interests. They will also receive an academic appointment as either a Clinical Assistant or Associate professor. Qualified candidates must be ABEM/ABOEM board eligible or certified.
